

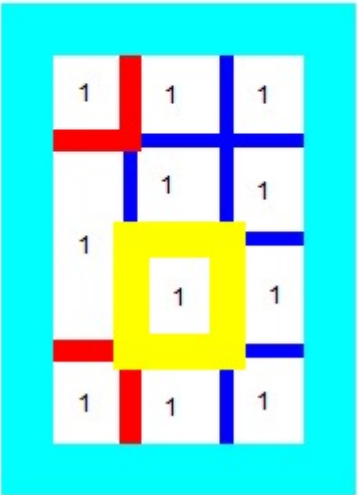
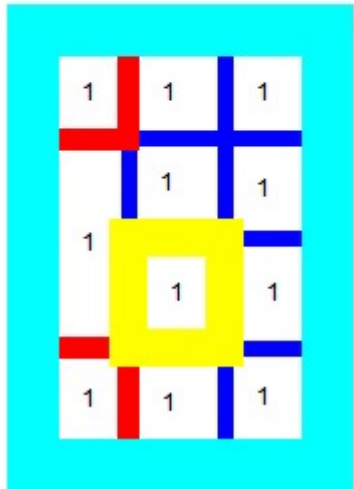
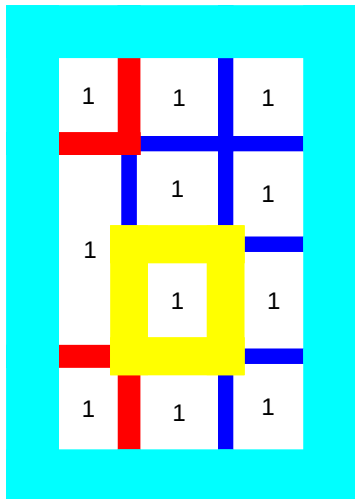
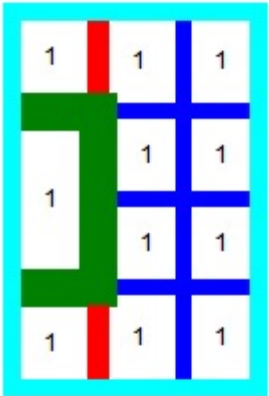
mPDF
